

Dear Resident,

We are reaching out to you to provide an update on the Clan Mothers Healing Village project. It's been some time, and the world is a different place since the last time we connected. Since our meetings last year, the professional team has made a lot of progress working with the Clan Mothers group on potential site development options and accompanying due diligence.

If you were not able to attend any of our community meetings, the following is a summary of what is being explored:

- The subject site is about 150 acres of beautifully treed land north of Mary Glenn Road
- The Clan Mothers would like to build a small Healing Village tucked away in the trees, for women of all walks who need to heal
- While some have worried that the idea is for a detox facility or halfway house for example, that is not what is planned
- At the Healing Village women will be taking part in healing activities such as sweat ceremonies, and land-based learning and education, including gardening and harvesting traditional foods and medicines.
- Nature and preservation are at the heart of the vision – traffic to and from the site will be very minimal, likely far less than is experienced currently in the cottage subdivision
- The Clan Mothers have deep roots grounded in the principles of respect, honour, and care for each other and for the land – they are excited to be good neighbours to people who have moved to this land over the past decades

We are currently working on selecting a preferred site development option and hope to be able to share this plan in Fall 2020. Owing to the current circumstances related to COVID-19, we have postponed any in-person meetings and will re-assess the situation in Fall. We will however be working on preparing a summary presentation that interested stakeholders can view on-line. In the meantime, we will be following the RM Council review of the Development Plan and Zoning By-law to express our interests in that document and to see what requirements may come out of it for this project.
