WHEREAS the Winnipeg Free Press September 6, 2019 edition reports that the City of Winnipeg has requested a two year extension from the province to comply with phosphorus limits on wastewater released from the North Main Sewage Treatment Facility;

AND WHEREAS it is reported that the City of Winnipeg has already obtained a five year extension from the province and must comply with its license requirements by December 31, 2019;

AND WHEREAS the environmental damage caused to Lake Winnipeg from the continued release of excessive phosphorous by the City of Winnipeg into the Red River is unacceptable;

AND WHEREAS this damage has severely impacted the health of Lake Winnipeg resulting in negative consequences to the tourism industry and property values in this community;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the Rural Municipality of Alexander request that the Province of Manitoba deny the extension request from the City of Winnipeg and compel the municipality to comply with the license requirements.
